- World Championship Zones 25 points for each cast win. Max 50 points.
- World Championship Finals 10 points for each cast win. No points for late round Friday. Max 40 points.

The UKC Triple Crown Challenge, sponsored by United Kennel Club, rewards the outstanding coonhound who earns the most Triple Crown points at the Winter Classic, Autumn Oaks, and the World Championship. The winner receives \$3,000 and a jacket courtesy of UKC. A dog must have participated in all three events to be eligible for the award.

After the first leg of the Triple Crown, the double cast winners at the Winter Classic held in Batesville, Mississippi would set the pace for the 2024 Triple Crown Challenge. Four Black & Tans, one Bluetick, six English, one Plott, one Redbone, and twelve Treeing Walkers made up the 25 frontrunners, all tied with 100 Triple Crown points.

Then came the second leg at Autumn Oaks in Richmond, Indiana. Out of the 25 double cast winners at Winter Classic, only eight hounds were able to add a cast win and 50 points to their resume at Oaks. Those eight hounds were 1) GRNITECH(3) 'PR' Bottomland Galcho, B&T, M, 3, Chad McCoin, Brad Hile, Hartford City, IN, 2) GRNITECH 'PR' Coon Creek Blue Gypsy, ENG, F, 5, Shane Hutcheson, Zach Maxey, Mansfield, OH, 3) NITECH 'PR' 7-Oaks Hardtime Stella 2, ENG, F, 1, Berle Shoulders, Sumner, IL, 4) GRNITECH(3) 'PR' June Bug's Joy, TW, F, 8, Rocky Baskerville, Portland, TN, 5) NITECH 'PR' Milk Money, TW, M, 7, Mike Guthrie, Mitchell, IN, 6) GRNITECH(3) 'PR' Rose's Wild Dreamin Echo, TW, M, 5, Logan Rose, Logan Estridge, Randy Sizemore, McKee, KY, 7) GRNITECH 'PR' Myers-Sullivan Milly, TW, F, 3, Haskell Myers, Doan Sullivan, Spencer, TN, and 8) NITECH 'PR' 4X 007, TW, M, 2, Trystan Short, Logan Williams, Mountain Grove, MO. At this point, there were 19 other hounds tied with 100 points that were still within striking distance going into the last leg of the yearly series.

Just two weeks later, the five Treeing Walker hounds, two English hounds, and the lone Black and Tan were heading into the third and final leg of the Triple Crown, the World Championship, starting with the Zones. As we sometimes see in this points race, there were five hounds eliminated from the race by not qualifying for the Zones during the year. Having said that, there would be a lot of eyes on the three remaining hounds tied for first, Galcho who was entered into the Quincy, Michigan Zone, Echo who was entered into the Rogersville, Tennessee Zone, and Stella who was entered into the Flora, Illinois Zone.

As results rolled in from Michigan on Friday of the Zones, Galcho was first on the board with a 725+ cast win, which not only gave him 175 points, but also put him in good position to advance to the Finals. Echo and Stella both lost their Friday night casts, putting them behind in the race. Saturday night would be different. Stella was not hunted on Saturday ending her year coming up just a little short. Galcho had a good cast, ending with 500+ but came up a little short on his cast. Down in Tennessee, news came in that Echo had won his cast tying the race. However, the 150+ cast win would be short of the points required to advance to the Finals, which in the Tennessee Zone which had a cutoff score of 200+. Galcho and Echo were deadlocked with 175 points and Galcho was heading to the World Finals.

When dogs are tied, the first tiebreaker according to the rules on the website is to go by highest total amount of plus points accrued in the dog's wins at the Triple Crown events during the year. So even if Galcho didn't win another cast, he had the lead on tiebreaker over Echo because of the dominating year he had at the Winter Classic, Autumn Oaks, and Zones, accruing 3,150+ points in his four cast wins. Those four wins were: 1,025+ on Friday at Winter Classic, 550+ on Saturday at Winter Classic, 850+ at Autumn Oaks, and 725+ on Friday night at the Zones.

There was however, one dog with an outside shot to make a run. NITECH 'PR' Voodoo Child, a Treeing Walker owned by Ashley Dalton of West Virginia had positioned himself to at least be in striking distance. With double cast wins at Winter Classic and double cast wins at the Jefferson, Ohio Zone, Voodoo had earned 150 points. That meant that

Galcho could sew it up with one cast win at the Finals. However, if Galcho lost his First-Round cast and Voodoo made a run to the Final Cast of the World Championship, that 30-point swing would change our winner. Voodoo was drawn onto Cast 1 and Galcho drew Cast 2. As the scorecards started rolling in, Voodoo and Galcho both fell a little short of advancing to Round 2, ending the race and making Galcho the 2024 Triple Crown Champion!
