MASTER OF HOUNDS REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES FOR A UKC LICENSE

- 1. Review all the information provided herein.
- 2. The applicant's character, honesty and integrity must be above reproach.
- 3. No applicant will be denied based on religion, race, color, national origin, or gender.
- 4. UKC insists the applicant have a minimum of three years active experience handling dogs in Nite Hunts to be considered for a Master of Hounds license.
- 5. The applicant must have a thorough knowledge of UKC's rules, policies and procedures and have demonstrated good judgment.
- 6. The applicant must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age.
- 7. Applicants must meet qualification requirements, apply, pay the applicable fee and pass the test.
- 8. All licenses for UKC Master of Hounds shall be granted or withheld at the sole discretion of United Kennel Club.
- 9. The licensed Master of Hounds must remain up to date on all rules and policies. Otherwise, they are subject to having their license revoked.
- **10.** Under no circumstances shall the applicant consider an assignment to serve as a Master of Hounds until they have received their license.
- **11.** Complete and submit the online application found here: www.ukcdogs.com/coonhound-rules-forms
- 12. A non-refundable fee of \$25 applies. The fee amount applies for each separate license that may be applied for at the same time.
- **13.** If approved, the applicant will receive an email providing the link to the test. The applicant is given 72 hours to complete and submit their test before the link expires.
- 14. Immediately following the completion of the test, the applicant will receive their test results. A passing grade will result in a license issued to the applicant. Should the applicant fail they are eligible to retest in six months.
- **15.** A new license is issued under a "temporary" status for a period of one year from the issue date and has served at no less than five licensed events.
- 16. During the temp status period, as noted above, the official may serve at regular club level events only. Further, those events shall not include specialty events such as a Sectional, World Qualifier, State Championships, Breed Championships etc.
- 17. Once a license is approved, the license is issued indefinitely. However, licenses are subject to review and may be withdrawn or revoked by UKC at any time.
